

Canoe Training: July 10 - 11, 2010



What: [Waterfront Canoeing Skills Tandem](#); [Lake Canoe Skills Introduction Tandem](#)
(Formerly flat water (tandem): Level A – C) canoe training.

When: Saturday, July 10th and Sunday, July 11th. 8 AM to 4:30 PM each day.

Where: Yoho Scout Reserve, Main Lodge

Who: This training is open to both scouting and non-scouting adults and youth 14 years of age and over.

How many spaces: Training will be offered to a maximum of 20 participants.

Cost:

- \$50 for Scouts Canada members
- \$60 for non-scouting youth and adults

Refunds: Any participant who cancels their registration before June 30th will receive a full refund.

Equipment:

Canoes and paddles will be available for any participants who do not have their own equipment. Some PFDs (life jackets) are available for loan, however all participants are strongly encouraged to provide their own PFD.

Facilities:

The Yoho lodge facility will be available for participants use, including access to washrooms and kitchen facilities.

Meals will not be provided – so all participants must bring a lunch for each day as well as appropriate snacks, etc. *Alcoholic beverages are not permitted.*

A more detailed list of what to bring will be provided upon receipt of your completed registration form.

Instruction: Will be provided by two Canoe – Kayak New Brunswick (CKNB) / Paddle Canada certified instructors.
