“The St. Croix lakes and river offer one of the finest canoeing experiences in eastern North America. Sparkling waters flow past forested shores and islands, with only nature in sight. Recognized as one of the most unspoiled recreational river corridors in the Northeast, valued by canoeists, fishermen and naturalists for its outstanding sport fishery resources, forested shorelands, backcountry recreational resources and wildlife habitat.”

If your answer is ‘yes’, join us for a week long, back country canoeing expedition on Spednic Lake and the St. Croix river.

This Scouts Canada sponsored ‘Extreme Adventure’ program is open to girls and boys.

You do not have to be a Scouts Canada member or have previous canoeing or camping experience. All you need is an adventurous spirit, a positive attitude and a love of the great outdoors.

The expedition will consist of 14 campers led by a team of three experienced adult leaders plus three senior youth counselors. All leaders have Scouts Canada screening.

The week will begin with drop-off on Friday evening, July 9th at the Yoho Lake Scout lodge, where we will stay for 2 days of canoe training on Saturday and Sunday.

On Monday we will travel to Spednic lake and spend 3 days exploring the lake and camping on the islands.

On Thursday we will begin a 2 day run down the St. Croix river from St. Croix to Loon Bay.

The week will finish-up on Friday afternoon, July 16th with pick-up at 4 pm back at the Yoho Scout Lodge.

The cost for this program is \$280 per person.
