Your group will represent a country that has not been discovered yet, but will be taking an active part in this Scouting Olympics.

*This camporee is open to **all Sections** – Beavers to Rovers inclusive, with special events for each section.*

Registration fee is \$10 per individual – this will cover the cracker barrel get together on Saturday evening, crest, numerous activities and lots of FUN, LAUGHTER AND FELLOWSHIP.

Cubs, Scouts, Venturers and Rovers will come self-contained. All meals will be the responsibility of the group.
